EXECUTIVE ORDER REQUIRING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF COLORADO TO APPEAR FOR THE STATE AND, IF WARRANTED, TO PROSECUTE CIVIL ACTIONS

WHEREAS, certain matters have come to the attention of the Governor of the State of Colorado concerning civil lawsuits filed by Rainsford Winslow and Winifred Winslow against the State of Colorado and its agents and employees; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has reviewed the merits of these lawsuits and is of the opinion that grounds exist for filing a civil action to enjoin Rainsford Winslow and Winifred Winslow from filing any further lawsuits or prosecuting any pending lawsuits without the representation of a licensed attorney; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 24-31-101(1), C.R.S. (1986), the Governor of the State of Colorado may grant the authority to the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to prosecute such a civil action on behalf of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has requested authorization to prosecute such an action on behalf of the State of Colorado;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby authorize the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to commence any and all civil actions against Rainsford Winslow and Winifred Winslow for the purpose of enjoining them from filing or prosecuting any civil action without first obtaining representation of a licensed attorney, or any other further such similar relief as is necessary, all in accordance with applicable law.
