EXECUTIVE ORDER

RESPONSIBILITY OF STATE AGENCIES REGARDING INMATES FURLOUGHED TO COLORADO BY OTHER STATES

WHEREAS, it is essential for local authorities to be notified when an inmate from another state is being allowed by that state to visit Colorado under the other state's authority to grant furloughs or paroles; and

WHEREAS, in the past there has been no uniformity in the manner in which state agencies receive such notification; and

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado has no authority to restrict the egress of an inmate properly authorized by another state to visit Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the public peace and dignity are better served by interagency cooperation and interstate communication;

WHEREAS, "inmates" for purpose of this Executive Order shall include inmates under legal jurisdiction, mental patients, and juvenile offenders.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

- The Colorado Bureau of Investigation, Colorado Crime Information Center, is designated as the agency to coordinate the dissemination of information about inmates from other states who are on furlough or parole in Colorado.
- 2. Any state agency receiving any transmission or communication which contains notification that an inmate of a correctional facility or mental hospital has been granted permission to visit the State of Colorado under the authority and law of that state shall forthwith relay that notification to the Colorado Bureau of Investigation, Colorado Crime Information Center, which shall keep that information and make it available to all authorities responsible for law enforcement in the counties and municipalities of the State of Colorado.

3. Nothing in this Executive Order is intended to imply nor designate any agency of the State of Colorado as having any responsibility whatsoever for any inmate in the technical custody of another state or another jurisdiction and is simply to provide for a communication network concerning inmates, parolees, and mental patients on furlough in Colorado.
