EXECUTIVE ORDER

JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA), was enacted on October 13, 1982, Public Law 97-300; and

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado desires to participate and receive financial assistance under the Job Training Partnership Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 125 of the Job Training Partnership Act requires that an organizational unit be responsible for oversight and management of a statewide comprehensive labor market and occupational supply and demand information system;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The Job Training Partnership Labor Market Information responsibilities (in accord with Sections 125 and 464 of the Job Training Partnership Act) shall be managed and reviewed by the Division of Planning in the Office of State Planning and Budget (OSPB).
2. OSPB shall insure that the Labor Market Information activities shall be conducted in close cooperation with, and as appropriate, through the State Occupational Information Coordinating Council (SOICC) and/or its member agencies. SOICC members shall include the Colorado Community College and Occupational Education System, Labor Market Information Section of the Department of Labor, Department of Labor and Employment, Division of Rehabilitation, Department of Social Services, Division of Commerce and Development and the Governor's Job Training Office, and other entities as its members deem appropriate.
3. OSPB shall chair the SOICC to insure adequate cooperation of all state agencies with this effort and shall serve as the permanent liaison with the Office of the Governor.
