

EXECUTIVE ORDER

REQUIRING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF COLORADO TO APPEAR FOR THE STATE AND, IF NECESSARY, TO PROSECUTE CIVIL ACTIONS

WHEREAS, certain matters have come to the attention of the Governor of the State of Colorado concerning a civil lawsuit filed by Cecil Sharp and Kathleen Sharp which involves the State of Colorado and its agents and employees; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has reviewed the merits of the lawsuit and is of the opinion that grounds exist for filing a civil action to intervene in the civil litigation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 24-31-101(1), C.R.S. (1986), the Governor of the State of Colorado may grant the authority to the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to prosecute such a civil action on behalf of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has requested authorization to prosecute such an action on behalf of the State of Colorado;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby authorize the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to intervene in the civil action filed by Cecil Sharp and Kathleen Sharp, or to pursue any other further such similar relief as is necessary, all in accordance with applicable law.
