EXECUTIVE ORDER

CHANGE IN TERMS FOR OIL OVERCHARGE FUNDS TO STATES AS A RESULT OF THE DECISIONS AND ORDERS OF THE STRIPPER WELL EXEMPTION LITIGATION, M.D.L. #378.

WHEREAS, Colorado received \$7,817,706 under the provisions of the Settlement Agreement and Order in the Stripper Well Exemption Litigation, M.D.L. #378; and

WHEREAS, the funds were originally allocated by Executive Order D009586, dated September 30, 1986; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the terms of the Executive Order;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the Settlement Agreement and Order of the United States District Court for the District of Kansas in Case M.D.L. #378, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT Executive Order D009586 be amended with the addition of the following allocation:

\$75,000 be allocated to The Metropolitan Air Quality Council to incorporate energy conservation programs into their efforts.
