EXECUTIVE ORDER

SUSPENDING THE DIRECTION TO STATE BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS TO ACQUIRE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING ACCESS TO PUBLIC LANDS

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. D0071 88, dated May 13, 1988, authorizes the State Board of Land Commissioners to acquire a designated right-of-way in Jefferson County through condemnation;

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Planning Commission is currently considering a rezoning application which relates to the proposed right-of-way;

WHEREAS, Jefferson County officials and the affected parties are attempting to negotiate and seek resolution of certain issues in the rezoning proceedings which might affect the need for the proposed right-of-way;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the state of Colorado, hereby suspend the effect and authority granted in executive order D0071 88 until such time as Jefferson County takes final action on the stated rezoning application.
