EXECUTIVE ORDER

PROCLAMATION

DECLARING DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR TORNADO DAMAGES IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER

- WHEREAS, on June 15, 1988, tornadoes touched down within the boundaries of the City and County of Denver causing extensive damage to private and public property;
- WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver, through its Mayor, Federico Pena, in a letter dated June 28, 1988, requested disaster emergency assistance from the state of Colorado;
- WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has informed me that homeowners and businesses sustained damages in excess of ten million dollars, including damage to 280 houses and 13 businesses;
- WHEREAS, the damages from the tornadoes also included extensive damage to public and private property including loss of trees on major avenues of the City; and
- WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver incurred significant emergency response costs in meeting and addressing the problems created by the emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me under the constitution and statutes of the state of Colorado, including Section 24-33.5-704, C.R.S., Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, do hereby find and declare that the June 15, 1988 tornadoes in the City and County of Denver constituted a disaster emergency requiring emergency action, and HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that the City and County of Denver receive disaster emergency funds in an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

This executive order shall expire after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended
