EXECUTIVE ORDER

CHANGE IN THE TERMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY FOR THE
DECISIONS AND ORDERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY FOR THE
OKC CORPORATION, December 13, 1985
STANDARD OIL COMPANY (INDIANA), April 24, 1986

- WHEREAS, Colorado has received \$1,214.26 under the provisions of the Decision and Order of the Department of Energy for the Coline Gasoline Corporation of May 21, 1985;
- WHEREAS, Colorado has received \$42,792.00 under the provisions of the Decision and Order of the Department of Energy for the OKC Corporation of December 13, 1985;
- WHEREAS, Colorado has received \$402,195.00 under the provisions of the Decision and Order of the Department of Energy for the Standard Oil Company (Indiana) of April 24, 1986;
- WHEREAS, interest has been earned on the funds at the federal and state level;
- WHEREAS, these funds were originally allocated by Executive Order D000187, dated January 8, 1987; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the terms of Executive Order D000187;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado pursuant to the Decisions and Orders of the Department of Energy for the Coline Gasoline Corporation, May 21, 1985, OKC Corporation, December 13, 1985, and Standard Oil Company (Indiana), April 24, 1986, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT Executive Order D000187 be amended with the following additions:

1. \$145,000 shall be disbursed to the Denver Regional Council of Governments for a traffic signal coordination program.
2. All remaining available funds shall be disbursed to the Department of Labor and Employment, Division of Labor, Oil and Gas Inspection Unit, for equipment purchases to upgrade their laboratory.
