EXECUTIVE ORDER

REQUIRING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF
COLORADO TO APPEAR FOR THE STATE AND,
IF WARRANTED, TO PROSECUTE CIVIL ACTIONS

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has advised the Governor of the State of Colorado about certain matters concerning the vacation by the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County of County Road 185 which provides access to lands owned by the State of Colorado and under the control of the State Board of Land Commissioners;

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has consulted with representatives of the State Board of Land Commissioners and is of the opinion that grounds exist for filing a civil action to enjoin the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County from vacating County Road 185;

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 24-31-101(1), C.R.S. (1982), the Governor of the State of Colorado may grant the authority to the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to apply for such relief on behalf of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General and the State Board of Land Commissioners have requested that the Governor grant such authority to the Attorney General;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby authorize the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to commence any and all civil actions against the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County for the purpose of enjoining it from vacating County Road 185.
