EXECUTIVE ORDER

REAFFIRMING A DISASTER EMERGENCY IN CLEAR CREEK COUNTY AND PROVIDING STATE DISASTER EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR SAME

- WHEREAS, on August 12, 1988, I declared a disaster emergency to exist in Clear Creek County to support an ongoing search and rescue operation;
- WHEREAS, this search and rescue operation was one of the largest search and rescue operations ever conducted in Colorado;
- WHEREAS, the expenses incurred by the Clear Creek County Sheriff's Department for managing this search and rescue operation were extraordinary;
- WHEREAS, in accordance with 24-33.5-707(11), Clear Creek County has requested state disaster emergency financial assistance in the amount of two thousand twenty-five dollars (\$2025);
- WHEREAS, the information provided by the County to support its request and the evaluation conducted by Division of Disaster Emergency Services support this request; and
- WHEREAS, this request is in the public interest;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me under the constitution and statutes of the state of Colorado, including Section 24-33.5-704, C.R.S. Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, do hereby affirm that a State of Disaster Emergency requiring emergency action existed and the impacts continue to exist in Clear Creek County for the reasons stated in my executive order of August 12, 1988 and those reasons stated above, and therefore order and direct that Clear Creek County receive disaster emergency funds in an amount not to exceed two thousand twenty-five dollars (\$2025). The conditions for this financial assistance are to be identified by the Division of Disaster Emergency Services.

This executive order shall expire after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended.
