EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General has informed me that Theodore Bundy may have some information which will allow the state of Colorado to resolve certain unsolved crimes;

WHEREAS, Mr. Bundy may provide certain information to the authorities of the state of Colorado that will require a physical inspection and search for evidence somewhere within the state of Colorado;

WHEREAS, the Colorado Bureau of Investigation is the proper agency in state government to undertake such an investigation; and

WHEREAS, the search could take place anywhere within the state of Colorado depending upon the information provided by Mr. Bundy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado and specifically C.R.S. Section 24-33.5-412(d) HEREBY ORDER the following:

The Colorado Bureau of Investigation is hereby ordered and authorized to undertake whatever investigation is necessary anywhere in the state of Colorado in search for evidence of unsolved crimes based on the information provided by Mr. Bundy.
