## EXECUTIVE ORDER

CHANGE IN TERMS FOR OIL OVERCHARGE FUNDS TO STATES  
AS A RESULT OF THE EXXON LITIGATION UNDER THE  
JUDGMENT AND ORDER OF THE U.S. DISTRICT COURT FOR  
THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA OF JUNE 7, 1983

WHEREAS, Colorado has received \$22,715,814 under the provisions of a Judgment and Order of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia resulting from the overpricing of petroleum products by the Exxon Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the funds were originally allocated in accordance with Executive Order D009286, dated September 4, 1986, and amended by Executive Orders D012686, dated December 23, 1986 and D005787, dated December 16, 1987; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the terms of these Executive Orders;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the Judgment and Order of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

Funds recaptured from distributees under the above-referenced Executive Orders may be reallocated by the Office of Energy Conservation either for new projects or to continue previously funded projects, up to a maximum new allocation of \$50,000 per project.
