## EXECUTIVE ORDER

CHANGE IN THE TERMS FOR OIL OVERCHARGE FUNDS  
 TO STATES AS A RESULT OF THE EXXON LITIGATION UNDER THE  
 JUDGMENT AND ORDER OF THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR  
 THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA DATED JUNE 7, 1983, AND THE STRIPPER WELL  
 LITIGATION, M.D.L. #378

WHEREAS, Colorado received \$22,715,814 under the provision of a Judgment and Order of the U.S. District Court of the District of Columbia resulting from the overpricing of petroleum products by the Exxon Corporation which was distributed in accordance with Executive Order D0092;

WHEREAS, Colorado received \$7,817,706 under the Order and Settlement Agreement in the Stripper Well Exemption Litigation, M.D.L. #378 which was distributed in accordance with Executive Order D0095 86;

WHEREAS, the above Executive Orders were amended by Executive Orders 126 86, dated December 23, 1986; D0057 87, dated December 16, 1987; D0060 88, dated January 20, 1988; D0086 88, dated September 6, 1988; D0096 88, dated October 17, 1988; D0112 89, dated March 31, 1989; D0113 89, dated March 31, 1989; D0114 89, dated March 31, 1989; and

WHEREAS, there is need to amend the terms of these Executive Orders;


NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the Judgment and Order of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia and the Settlement Agreement and Order of the U.S. District Court for the District of Kansas in Case M.D.L. #378, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

The \$1,250,000 distributed to the Denver Partnership for the engineering efforts with the cross mall transit connections which are part of the Downtown Area Plan, subject to the condition that privately raised funds be available for construction purposes under the Stripper Well Settlement, be amended in the following manner:

\$1,250,000 be distributed to the Denver Partnership for the engineering efforts associated with the cross mall transit connections which are part of the Downtown Area Plan, with \$925,000 to be made available for preliminary

design work, including not more than \$75,000 for environmental assessments and the remaining \$325,000 held until privately raised funds are available for construction purposes; \$682,350 of this amount is to be allocated from the Exxon Funds and \$567,650 is to be allocated from Stripper Well funds.
