EXECUTIVE ORDER

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a fund balance exists in the Disaster Emergency Fund appropriated to the Governor's Office for fiscal year 1988-1989;

WHEREAS, drought conditions in Colorado are causing extreme danger from fires, soil erosion, danger to wildlife, and danger to water supplies for domestic, agricultural and other uses;

WHEREAS, it is foreseeable that these current conditions may require use of the fund balance in the Disaster Emergency Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me under the constitution and laws of the State of Colorado including Section 24-33.5-704, C.R.S. of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, do hereby declare and direct that any remaining fund balance remaining in the Disaster Emergency Fund at the end of fiscal year 1988-1989 should be rolled forward to be available and used for any disaster emergencies in fiscal year 1989-1990, and then, in accord with the Disaster Emergency Act and other applicable law.
