EXECUTIVE ORDER

REAFFIRMING A DISASTER EMERGENCY IN DOLORES COUNTY
AND PROVIDING STATE DISASTER EMERGENCY
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR SAME

WHEREAS, on June 30, 1989, I declared a disaster emergency to exist in the Town of Rico, Dolores County due to underground flooding from Silver Creek;

WHEREAS, under the executive order declaring this disaster emergency, I directed the State Department of Natural Resources to provide technical assistance to the Town of Rico;

WHEREAS, the State Geological Survey Department of Natural Resources has requested additional funding authorization for the purpose of providing continuing technical assistance;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Division of Disaster Emergency Services that this request is both necessary and justified and if such assistance were not forthcoming the public health and safety would be threatened.

NOW, therefore, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me under Section 24-33.5-704 C.R.S. of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, do hereby affirm that a State of Disaster Emergency requiring emergency action existed and the danger continues to exist in the Town of Rico, Dolores County, for the reasons stated in my executive order of June 30, 1989, and those reasons stated above, and therefore order and direct continued technical assistance be provided by the State Department of Natural Resources as deemed appropriate. Expenses incurred for this assistance which is assistance in addition to that authorized in Executive Order D0135 89 to be reimbursed to the Department from the State Disaster Emergency Fund in an amount not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000) based on actual costs for providing such service.
