<u>EXECUTIVE ORDER</u>

AMENDMENT TO THE EXECUTIVE ORDER ON THE DISTRIBUTION OF EXXON OIL OVERCHARGE FUNDS UNDER THE JUDGMENT AND ORDER OF THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA OF JUNE 7, 1983

- WHEREAS, Colorado was allocated \$22,715,814 under the provisions of the Exxon Case;
- WHEREAS, those funds were originally allocated by Executive Order DO092 86, dated September 4, 1986 and amended by Executive Orders DO126 86, dated December 23, 1986 and DO057 87, dated December 16, 1987;
- WHEREAS, under those Executive Orders, \$200,000 was allocated to the Department of Administration, Division of Purchasing, for the purposes of Title D of Title III of the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (relating to primary and supplemental state energy conservation programs) for the continuation of the energy conservation program in state purchasing; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the terms of Executive Orders D0092 86, D00126 86 and D0057 87;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado pursuant to the Decision and Order of the Exxon case DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

Of the remaining \$62,250 of the \$200,000 allocated as above referenced to the Department of Administration, \$37,250 shall be distributed to the Office of Energy Conservation for the purpose of hiring a consultant for program delivery and \$25,000 shall be distributed to the Department of Administration, Division of Purchasing for purposes of Part D of Title III of the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (Relating to primary and supplemental state energy conservation programs) for the continuation of the energy conservation program in state purchasing.
