## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF PROGRAM INTEGRITY IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 8-1-107 and C.R.S. 8-72-101, the Executive Director of the Department of Labor and Employment is required to administer and enforce the provisions of all articles under said titles, and to protect the security and integrity of the funds administered under said provisions; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the above stated purpose in an efficient and economical manner, it is necessary to establish a specified Office of Program Integrity sub-unit within the Department of Labor and Employment, the principal purpose of which shall be the administration of criminal justice;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, by power vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado do hereby establish a sub-unit within the Department of Labor and Employment, which shall be designated as the Office of Program Integrity, the principal purpose of which shall be the administration of criminal justice as defined by 28 C.F.R. 20.3(C)(2)(d).

I FURTHER ORDER that a substantial part of the annual budget of the Office of Program Integrity be allocated to the administration of criminal justice.
