EXECUTIVE ORDER

DECLARING A DISASTER EMERGENCY AND ORDERING TO STATE
ACTIVE DUTY PART OF THE COLORADO NATIONAL GUARD

WHEREAS, blizzard conditions prevailed in several locations in the State of Colorado on March 6, 1990;

WHEREAS, blizzard conditions caused numerous highways to be closed;

WHEREAS, numerous vehicles were stranded and it became obvious that Colorado National Guard resources were needed to assist in clearing the highways and bringing stranded motorists to safety; and

WHEREAS, this justification and the recitals made above were verified to me by the Division of Disaster Emergency Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me under Section 24-33.5-704, C.R.S., of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM that a state of disaster emergency exists for the reasons set forth under the provisions of 28-3-104, C.R.S. the Adjutant General may order persons to State active duty with pay. The Adjutant General shall determine the number of individuals assigned to this duty, and equipment deployed on this matter.

This Executive Order shall expire after thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended.
