EXECUTIVE ORDER

PROVIDING STATE EMERGENCY FUNDS FOR THE JUNE 6, 1990 DISASTER IN LINCOLN COUNTY

WHEREAS, on June 7, 1990 by Executive Order D0011 90, I declared a disaster emergency in Lincoln County and ordered to state active duty the Colorado National Guard in response to the tornado that struck the community of Limon;

WHEREAS, under the Executive Order I ordered that Lincoln County was entitled to aid, relief and assistance pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973;

WHEREAS, under Section 24-33.5-704 and 24-33.5-706 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, the Governor may suspend the provisions of law and regulations to cope with the emergency and may transfer and expend monies appropriated for other purposes to meet the needs of the disaster emergency if the funds regularly appropriated to state and local agencies and the disaster emergency fund are insufficient;

WHEREAS, the conditions under which funds can be transferred and used to meet the needs of the disaster emergency have been satisfied in connection with the disaster emergency needs within Lincoln County;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, including the provisions of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, Section 24-33.5-701 et. seq., C.R.S. (1988 repl. vol.), HEREBY ORDER:

1. That \$552,000 be transferred from the State's General Fund Reserve into a general ledger account designated by the Department of Public Safety. That these funds in the amounts indicated be used for disaster recovery activities and emergency defense costs.
2. That these funds be replaced from State fiscal year 1989-1990 General Fund reversions when they become available.

3. That a report be provided to me and the General Assembly identifying how the funds were utilized, once all transactions have been completed.
4. That the remaining fund balance be allowed to revert to the General Fund Reserve, once all transactions are completed.
