AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER DO015 90
BANNING OPEN BURNING IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF COLORADO

Executive Order D0015 90, dated June 26, 1990, banning open burning in designated areas of Colorado, is amended by inclusion of the following:

Open burning is prohibited in the following designated areas of Colorado:

The counties of Alamosa, Boulder, Conejos, Costilla, Custer, Douglas, Elbert, El Paso, Fremont, Gilpin, Huerfano, Jefferson, Larimer, Las Animas, Mineral, Park, Pueblo, Rio Grande, Saguache, Teller.

- 2. The restrictions on open burning effected by the Executive Order, in Colorado shall be in effect beginning at 3 p.m. on June 29, 1990, and shall remain in effect until amended or rescinded by Executive Order.
- 3. For the purposes of clarification, Executive Order D0015 90 and this amendment ban the use of fireworks, as defined in C.R.S. 12-28-101 (1) (a), except that the restrictions shall not apply to legal fireworks at private residences within incorporated city limits, or private residences in unincorporated areas which are located on developed lots not surrounded by forest vegetation, or those firework displays authorized by local sheriffs and fire chiefs.
