EXECUTIVE ORDER

AMENDMENT TO THE EXECUTIVE ORDER ON THE DISTRIBUTION OF EXXON OIL OVERCHARGE FUNDS UNDER THE JUDGMENT AND ORDER OF THE UNITED STATE DISTRICT FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA OF JUNE 7, 1983

WHEREAS, Colorado was allocated \$22,715,814 under the provisions of the Exxon case;

WHEREAS, those funds were originally allocated by Executive Order D009286, dated September 4, 1986 and amended by Executive Orders D0126 86, dated December 23, 1986 and D0057 87, dated December 16, 1987 and D0014 89, dated March 31, 1989 and D0016 89, dated April 25, 1989 and D0148 89, dated October 5, 1989, and D0027 90, dated August 7, 1990; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the terms of these Executive Orders;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado pursuant to the Judgement and Order of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

- 1. \$138,000 shall be allocated to the Energy in Community Development Program for grants to five energy efficient model communities;
- 2. \$182,370 shall be allocated to the Colorado Office of Energy Conservation for a renewable resource program;
- 3. \$53,521 shall be allocated to continue the Energy Conservation in Purchasing program to be performed in conjunction with the Colorado Division of Purchasing;
- 4. \$59,013 shall be allocated to the Colorado Office of Energy Conservation for a small business energy management program;
- 5. \$373,093 shall be allocated to the Colorado Office of Energy Conservation for a residential energy program; and

6. \$500,000 shall be re-allocated from the original \$1.5 million allocation in Executive Order D0027 90 for a transportation demonstration project and a source reduction awareness campaign.
