EXECUTIVE ORDER

REGARDING REVENUE ESTIMATES

- WHEREAS, the revenue estimate for the current fiscal year, prepared in accordance with Section 24-75-201.3(2), 10B C.R.S. (1991 Supp.), indicates that general fund expenditures for fiscal year 1991-92 based on appropriations now in effect will result in the use of one-third or more of the reserve required by Section 24-75-201.1(1)(d), 10B C.R.S. (1991 Supp.);
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 24-75-201.5, 10B C.R.S. (1991 Supp.), the Governor is instructed to formulate a plan for reducing such general fund expenditures so that said reserve, as of the close of the fiscal year, will be at least two-thirds of the amount required by Section 24-75-201.1(1)(d), 10B C.R.S. (1991 Supp.);
- WHEREAS, Section 24-75-201.5, 10B C.R.S. (1991 Supp.) requires the Governor to promptly notify the General Assembly of such plan and to implement such plan, using the procedures set forth in Sections 24-2-102(4), 24-30-206(3), or 24-50-109.5, or any other lawful means;
- Section 24-2-102(4), 10A C.R.S. (1991 Supp.), WHEREAS, provides that if during any fiscal year there sufficient revenues available expenditure during such period to carry on the functions of the state government and support its agencies and institutions and such fact is made to appear to the Governor, in the exercise of his discretion, by executive order, he may suspend or discontinue, in whole or in the functions part, or services of department, board, bureau or agency of state government;

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly has made some reduction in expenditures in the extraordinary session convened on September 10, 1991;

WHEREAS, the General Assembly's reductions are not sufficient to prevent general fund expenditures for the fiscal year based on appropriations now in effect to result in the use of one-third or more of the reserve required by Section 24-75-201.1(1)(d), 10B C.R.S. (1991 Supp.);

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 16 of the Colorado Constitution requires that the State of Colorado shall have a balanced budget; and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 2 vests the supreme executive authority of the state in the the governor, who shall take care that the laws be faithfully executed.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby order:

- 1. Pursuant to the plan attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein ("Plan"), the functions or services of the departments, boards, bureaus, and agencies of the state government described in the attached plan shall be discontinued or suspended as set forth in the plan, upon the effective date of this Executive Order. The General Assembly, under separate cover, has been notified of the Plan today.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 24-2-102(4), 10A C.R.S. (1991 Supp.), this Executive Order shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on November 1, 1991.
- 3. This Executive Order shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on January 31, 1992, unless it is so extended pursuant to Section 24-2-102(4), 10A C.R.S. (1991 Supp.).
