## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### POLICY ON ACCESSIBILITY FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336) ("Act") was signed into law on July 26 1990;

WHEREAS, significant sections of the Act applicable to state and local government go into effect on January 26, 1992;

WHEREAS, the state recognizes that it has legal obligations under Title I (Employment) and Title II (State and Local Government) of the Act;

WHEREAS, persons with disabilities are entitled to all the rights, benefits and privileges offered by the state of Colorado to its other residents, including equal access to its programs and services;

WHEREAS, the state recognizes there exists a large pool of available and qualified disabled Americans interested in all aspects of employment opportunities;

WHEREAS, the state shall strive to integrate persons with disabilities by providing equal access and equal opportunity into all aspects of life;

WHEREAS, the state as an employer strives to provide the equipment and support needed by its employees for the efficient, effective performance of their duties;
