EXECUTIVE ORDER

ALLOWING TOWN OF LIMON TO ACCESS UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK FUND FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES CAUSED BY JUNE 6, 1990 DISASTER

- WHEREAS, on Wednesday evening, June 6, 1990, a tornado struck the community of Limon, Colorado;
- WHEREAS, the Governor inspected the scene of the tornado on June 6 and June 7, and witnessed the extensive destruction caused thereby;
- WHEREAS, the Governor proclaimed on June 7, 1990 by Executive Order D0011 90 that a state of disaster emergency existed in Limon;
- WHEREAS, the tornado destroyed the firehouse belonging to the Town of Limon, necessitating the acquisition of land for the construction of a new firehouse;
- WHEREAS, the site of the new firehouse was at a location that had formerly housed a leaking underground storage tank;
- WHEREAS, the Town of Limon voluntarily and rapidly cleaned up the contamination leaking from the tank;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Colorado DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

 Any regulation or statute making the Town of Limon ineligible to receive reimbursement from the leaking underground storage tank fund created by section 25-18-109, 11A C.R.S. (1989) is hereby suspended in regard to any reimbursement application by the Town of Limon for cleanup of the site of the new firehouse. Executive Order Page 2

2. This Order is made pursuant to my authority under section 24-33.5-704(7)(a), 10A C.R.S. (1988), and based upon my determination that strict compliance with the eligibility requirements would unfairly penalize Limon for taking necessary action to cope with the disaster emergency.
