EXECUTIVE ORDER

CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1992 FUNDS UNDER THE LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Section 2604(f) of Public Law 97-35 as amended by Public Law 98-588 and Public Law 99-425, authorizes a state to transfer for the support of specified programs up to 10 percent of funds received from the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance block grant made to this state pursuant to Title XX of the Social Security Act; and

WHEREAS, there are funds unexpended within the time limitation of the State of Colorado's Low-Income Energy Assistance Program in federal fiscal year 1992; and

WHEREAS, it is advisable to ensure continuing levels of services provided under the block grant made to this state pursuant to Title XX of the Social Security Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Colorado DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. \$1,200,000 of the block grant made for Low Income Home Energy Assistance for federal fiscal year 1992 be transferred to support activities and services provided under Title XX of the Social Security Act in Colorado.
