EXECUTIVE ORDER

CHANGE IN TERMS FOR OIL OVERCHARGE FUNDS TO STATES
 AS A RESULT OF THE DECISIONS AND ORDERS OF THE
 STRIPPER WELL EXEMPTION LITIGATION, CASE M.D.L. #378

WHEREAS, Colorado has received \$13,018,639.84 under the provisions of the Settlement Agreement and Order in the Stripper Well Exemption Litigation, M.D.L. #378; and

WHEREAS, \$7,817,706 was originally allocated by Executive Order D0097 86, dated September 30, 1986, and amended by Executive orders D0126 86, dated December 23, 1986; D0057 87, dated December 16 1987; D0060 88, dated January 20, 1988, dated October 17, 1988; D0016 89, dated April 25, 1989; D0121 89, dated May 30, 1989; D0025 90, dated August 1, 1990; and B023 91, dated July 10, 1991; and


WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the terms of these Executive Orders;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement and Order of the U.S. District Court for the District of Kansas in Case M.D.L. #378, the above-referenced Executive Orders shall be amended with the following addition:

\$37,086 shall be allocated to the Colorado Office of Energy Conservation to continue the previously funded solid waste reduction/management program.
