EXECUTIVE ORDER

ESTABLISHING THE INVESTIGATIONS AND CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT SECTION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 8-1-107, C.R.S. 8-47-101, and C.R.S. 8-72-101, the Executive Director of the Department of Labor and Employment is required to administer and enforce the provisions of all articles under said titles, and to protect the security and integrity of the funds administered under said provisions; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the above stated purpose in an efficient and economical manner, it is necessary to establish a specified Investigations and Criminal Enforcement Section within the Department of Labor and Employment, the principal purpose of which shall be the administration of criminal justice as defined by 28 C.F.R 20.3(C)(2)(d).

I FURTHER ORDER that a substantial part of the annual budget of the Investigations and Criminal Enforcement Section be allocated to the administration of criminal justice.
