EXECUTIVE ORDER

FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS
FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
TO THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS

- WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services is the recipient of funds under the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 (P.L. 97-35); hereafter referred to as the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP); and
- WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Human Services is the recipient of funds for the LIEAP Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Low-Income Energy Assistance Act of 1981 allows up to 15 percent of the funds to be used for low cost residential weatherization or other energy related home repair for low-income households; and
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that the provision of low cost residential weatherization services will provide long range benefits for Colorado's low-income population; and
- WHEREAS, the Division of Housing in the Colorado
 Department of Local Affairs is best able to use
 the weatherization funds to serve Colorado's
 low-income populations.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws and Constitution of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The Colorado Department of Local Affairs is designated as the responsible agency to administer a low-cost weatherization program.

- 2. The low-cost weatherization program shall be administered in accordance with all federal laws and regulations.
- 3. The Department of Local Affairs shall receive \$3,390,397 from the Colorado Department of Human Services, including \$217,288 for administrative costs and \$3,104,109 for weatherization services. Of the total, \$3,321,397 shall come from the LIEAP Block grant and \$69,000 from the Leveraging Incentive program award.
