STATE NON PROFIT ENTITIES

EXECUTIVE ORDER

- WHEREAS, state executive departments currently establish non-profit organizations to assist them in fulfilling their statutory responsibilities and serving their clients; and
- WHEREAS, these non-profit organizations may receive and spend money in the name of and on behalf of the State of Colorado; and
- WHEREAS, the Governor is responsible for the operations of the Executive branch; and
- WHEREAS, non-profits created by Executive departments should be held accountable for their financial and programmatic operations; and
- WHEREAS, further creation of non-profit entities by state departments should be limited and justified prior to their creation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby order that:

- After the date of this Executive Order, an executive department may establish a new non-profit entity only upon written approval of the Governor.
- 2. Any request to approve the creation of a non-profit entity must include the following information: the name of the entity; the source of revenue including any state department revenues or payments for funding the entity; the name of persons who will serve on the Board of Directors of the non-profit; the reason for creating the non-profit; and a statement from the executive director setting forth the reasons the non-profit is necessary to further the Adepartment's business.
