EXECUTIVE ORDER

AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER D0006 95 DECLARING A DISASTER EMERGENCY DUE TO THE IMMINENT THREAT OF FLOODING AND LANDSLIDES

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order D0006 95, a disaster emergency exists due to the threat of flooding and landslides; and
- WHEREAS, flooding and landslides have occurred and the state and local governments have experienced a loss of property resulting in expenses that are beyond the ability of the state and local governments to absorb within existing budgets; and
- WHEREAS, flood and landslide related damages are estimated to exceed nine million dollars (\$9,000,000) in public expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Romer, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, including §28-32-2104, C.R.S., the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1992, do hereby order that Executive Order D0006 95, dated June 8, 1995, is amended with the deletion of paragraph 2 and the insertion of the following new paragraph in its entirety in its place:

2. Two million nine hundred thousand dollars (\$2,900,000) be transferred from the state's General Fund unrestricted reserve into the State Disaster Emergency Fund from sources identified by the State Office of Planning and Budgeting to governments' support the state and local mitigation, preparedness, initial emergency response activities, and disaster emergency flooding or response needs as a result of landslides.
