EXECUTIVE ORDER

CHANGE OF REPRESENTATION

APPOINTMENT WILDLIFE COMMISSION

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Governor of the State of Colorado, I, Bill Owens, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order directing Bernard L. Black to serve on the Wildlife Commission as a sportsmen.

Bernard L. Black of Denver was appointed to the Wildlife Commission as a member of the public at large on September 24, 1997, for a term expiring March 1, 2001. He was therefore serving on the Wildlife Commission on January 1, 2000. Colorado Revised Statutes, section 33-1-103(b)(III), specifies that only those members appointed after January 1, 2000, must serve their entire terms representing the category for which they were originally appointed. Therefore the category Bernard L. Black represents may be changed at any time during his term.

ORDERED:

That Bernard L. Black of Denver shall hereafter serve on the Wildlife Commission as a sportsman pursuant to C.R.S. 33-1-103(b)(III).
