Michell D. Padilla of Brighton, Colorado, to serve as a representative of parent of a person with a disability, appointed;

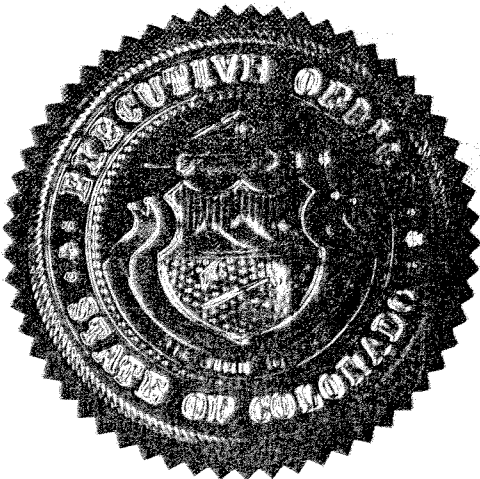
Michael G. JunTunen of Vail, Colorado, to serve as a person with a disability, appointed;
