EXECUTIVE ORDER

INTERIM APPOINTMENT ATTORNEY GENERAL

The Office of Attorney General is vacated, effective at 10:00 a.m. on January 4, 2005, due to the resignation of Ken Salazar.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Governor of the State of Colorado, and, in particular, Article IV, Section 6(2) of the Constitution of the State of Colorado, I, Bill Owens, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order appointing a fit person to discharge the duties of the Office of Attorney General.

ORDERED:

That John W. Suthers of Colorado Springs, Colorado, be and is hereby appointed to discharge the duties of the Office of Attorney General pursuant to Article IV, Section 6(2) of the Constitution of the State of Colorado. This appointment shall be effective on January 4, 2005, until such time as I nominate and appoint, by and with the consent of the Senate, the successor to the Office of Attorney General.
