Executive Order Office of Energy Management and Conservation

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Governor of the State of Colorado, I, Bill Owens, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order recreating the Office of Energy and Conservation as the Office of Energy Management and Conservation.

1. Background and Need.

The Office of Energy Conservation ("the Office") serves an important and expanding role in state government as part of the Office of the Governor. Modernization of the name of the Office is needed to recognize this expanding role. As a complement to energy conservation, the Office has placed increasing emphasis on energy management issues. One example of this progression is the focus on energy management in order to reduce air pollution. The Office is also involved with electric utility issues and alternative energy utilization. By signing this Executive Order, I am changing the name of the Office of Energy Conservation to the Office of Energy Management and Conservation to recognize its modern mission.

2. Mission and Order.

I hereby order the Office of Energy Conservation to be renamed as the Office of Energy Management and Conservation.

3. Past Executive Orders Superceded and Replaced.

This Executive Order shall repeal and replace all previous executive orders pertaining to the name of the Office of Energy Conservation and specifically unnumbered Executive Order entitled "Establishing the Colorado Office of Energy Conservation and the Position of Director of such Office" dated August 10, 1977, and Executive Order D003 90, The Colorado Office of Energy Conservation.
