Dr. Wade R. Smith of Denver, Colorado, a board-certified surgeon providing trauma care at a Level I trauma center, and a Republican, reappointed;


Raymond A. Coniglio of Westminster, Colorado, a trauma nurse coordinator, and a Democrat, reappointed;
