#### **EXECUTIVE ORDER**

### **Rescinding Executive Order D 005 09**

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Governor of the State of Colorado, I, Bill Ritter, Jr. Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order rescinding Executive Order D 005 09.

## I. Background and Purpose

Beginning early on the morning of March 26, 2009, a blizzard hit the State and impacted traffic safety, including causing the closure of U.S. Highway 36 between Westminster and Boulder and stranding motorists who required rescue. As Governor, I ordered "that \$200,000 be transferred from the Major Medical Insurance Fund to the Disaster Emergency Fund." However, as the situation unfolded, the state response did not require these funds, and the transfer never took place. The presence of a credit, but not a cash transfer, on the balance sheet of the Disaster Emergency Fund now requires resolution. Therefore, this order rescinds Executive Order D 005 09, allowing the \$200,000 to remain in the Major Medical Insurance Fund.

# II. <u>Directive</u>

I hereby rescind Executive Order D 005 09.
