EXECUTIVE ORDER

Concerning Calling Certain Elements of Colorado National Guard to State Active Duty for the Purpose of Force Protection and Extending Executive Order D 007 06

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado and, in particular, pursuant to Article IV, sections 2 and 5 of the Colorado Constitution and C.R.S. § 28-3-104, I, Bill Ritter, Jr., Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order amending and extending Executive Orders D 007 06, D 022 06, D 024 07, D 019 08, and D 018 09, calling certain elements of the Colorado National Guard to state active duty for the purpose of force protection.

Section 4 of Executive Order D 007 06, which was amended by Executive Orders D 022 06, D 024 07, D 019 08, and D 018 09, is amended to read as follows:

4. <u>Duration</u>

This Executive Order shall continue without interruption and shall expire on the 30th day of September 2011, unless further extended or amended by subsequent Executive Order.

In all other respects, Executive Order D 007 06 remains in full force and effect as originally promulgated.
