EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Judith A. Lopez

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Judith A. Lopez.

I. Background

In 1981, Judith Lopez pleaded guilty to Second Degree Forgery (F-4) in Denver County, Colorado (81CR1322) and Attempted Theft (F-4) in Adams County, Colorado (81CR590). In 1987, Judith Lopez pleaded guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance (F-3) in Denver County, Colorado (87CR072) and Theft (M-2) in Jefferson County, Colorado (87F536). Judith Lopez completed the terms of her sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Judith A. Lopez be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of her rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of her civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
