### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### Full and Unconditional Pardon Charles W. Pope

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Charles W. Pope.

#### I. Background

In 1962, Charles Pope pleaded guilty to Taking Parts Off of a Motor Vehicle in Delta County, Colorado (X1003). In 1967, Charles Pope pleaded guilty to felony Grand Larceny in Montrose County, Colorado (X1913). Charles Pope completed the terms of his sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

#### II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Charles W. Pope be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
