EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Frances A. Sagel

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Frances A. Sagel.

I. Background

In 1996, Frances Sagel pleaded guilty to two counts of Forgery (F-5) in Morgan County, Colorado (94CR77) and one count of Issuance of a Bad Check (M-3) in Weld County, Colorado (94M930). Frances Sagel completed the terms of her sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this elemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Frances A. Sagel be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of her rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of her civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
