### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### Full and Unconditional Pardon Michell B. Cabaniss

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Michell B. Cabaniss.

#### I. Background

In 1990, Michell Cabaniss pleaded guilty to Criminal Attempt to Commit Sale of a Controlled Substance, Schedule I (F-4) in Larimer County, Colorado (90CR120). Michell Cabaniss completed the terms of her sentence. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

#### II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Michell B. Cabaniss be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described conviction.
- B. All of her rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of her civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with this conviction are removed.
