EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Brian J. Clear

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Brian J. Clear.

I. Background

In 1994, while a juvenile, Brian Clear pleaded guilty to Criminal Mischief (F-4) and two counts of Second Degree Burglary (F-4) (94JV61); Criminal Attempt: Extreme Indifference Murder (F-2); First Degree Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft (F-4); Aggravated Juvenile Offender, Violation of Bail Bond (F-6) (94JV327); and Menacing with Deadly Weapon (F-5) (94CR63), all in Mesa County, Colorado. Brian Clear completed the terms of his sentence. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Brian J. Clear be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
