

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Scott A. Wright

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Scott A. Wright.

I. Background

In 1995, Scott A. Wright pleaded guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance (F-3) and Harassment (M-3) in Arapahoe County, Colorado (95CR216). Scott A. Wright also pleaded guilty to Criminal Impersonation (F-6) in Douglas County, Colorado (96CR277). Scott A. Wright completed the terms of his sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this elemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Scott A. Wright be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with this conviction are removed.
