

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Chad F. Armenta

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Chad F. Armenta.

I. Background

In 2003, Chad F. Armenta pleaded guilty to Possession of a Schedule II Controlled Substance (F-4) in Chaffee County, Colorado (2003CR17). In 2005, Chad F. Armenta also was found guilty of Manufacture of a Schedule II Controlled Substance (F-3) and Theft – Under \$100 (M-3) in Chaffee County, Colorado (2003CR132). Chad F. Armenta completed the terms of his sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Chad F. Armenta be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
