EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Tonya N. Mooningham

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Tonya N. Mooningham.

I. Background

In 2003, Tonya N. Mooningham pleaded guilty to Possession of 1–8 Ounces of Marihuana (M-1) (2003CR329) and Distribution of 25–450 Grams of a Schedule II Controlled Substance (F-3) (2003CR61) in El Paso County, Colorado. In 2005, Tonya N. Mooningham pleaded guilty to Unlawful Use of a Schedule II Controlled Substance (F-6) in El Paso County, Colorado (2004CR5549). Tonya N. Mooningham completed the terms of her sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Tonya N. Mooningham be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of her rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of her civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
