### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### Full and Unconditional Pardon John F. Buehler

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to John F. Buehler.

#### I. Background

In 1984, John F. Buehler pleaded guilty to two counts of 2nd Degree Burglary in Summit County, Colorado (1984CR23 and 1984CR47). John F. Buehler completed the terms of his sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

#### II. Grant of Clemency

- A. John F. Buehler be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
