EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Beth M. Stone

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Beth M. Stone.

I. Background

In 2005, Beth M. Stone pleaded guilty to Forgery - Check/Commercial Instrument in Denver County, Colorado (2005CR1761). In 2006, Beth M. Stone pleaded guilty to Trespass 1st Degree/Auto W/Intent to Commit Crime (2005CR20) and to Trespass 1st Degree/Auto W/Intent to Commit Crime (2005CR494) in Douglas County, Colorado. Beth M. Stone completed the terms of her sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Beth M. Stone be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of her rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored without condition. All of her civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
