EXECUTIVE ORDER

Commutation of Sentence Frederick C. Harris

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order commuting the sentence of Frederick C. Harris.

I. Background

In 2000, Frederick C. Harris, DOC Reg. No. 82086, was sentenced to the Department of Corrections for 96 years for Controlled Substance - Distribution of Schedule II (1999CR2286). His current estimated parole eligibility date is in 2042. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this commutation is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Frederick C. Harris be and hereby is granted a limited commutation such that he is granted parole effective January 15, 2021. The Parole Board shall set the terms and conditions of Mr. Harris' parole.
- B. This grant of clemency is limited to paroling Mr. Harris effective January 15, 2021, with terms and conditions of parole to be set by the Parole Board, and shall not in any way affect the underlying criminal conviction.
