EXECUTIVE ORDER

Full and Unconditional Pardon Michael D. Jordan

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Michael D. Jordan.

I. Background

In 1997, Michael D. Jordan pleaded guilty to Manufacture, Distribution, and Sale of Marijuana and Possession of a Defaced Firearm in Jefferson County, Colorado (1997CR808). Michael D. Jordan completed the terms of his sentence. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Michael D. Jordan be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
