### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### **Full and Unconditional Pardon Joseph M. Dacosta Murillo**

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Joseph M. Dacosta Murillo.

#### **I. Background**

In 1982, 1983, and 1988, Joseph M. Dacosta Murillo pleaded guilty to Assault in Pueblo County, Colorado (1982F3388), Conspiracy to Commit 2nd Degree Burglary in El Paso County (1983CR542), and Possession Controlled Substance in Denver County (1988CR778), respectively. Joseph M. Dacosta Murillo completed the terms of his sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

#### **II. Grant of Clemency**

- A. Joseph M. Dacosta Murillo be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
